Attendance

Attendance notifications will be automatically sent out daily for students with absences. Automated phone calls through the Parentlink system will be completed every school day. Unapproved letters will be sent home on the 3rd, 5th, and 7th unapproved absence. The 7th unapproved absence letter is the Denial of Credit Notification. The student has accrued more than six (6) unapproved absences in the class. The Clark County School District Regulation 5113 limits unapproved absences in any class to seven (7) per semester. Students will not earn credit for that course that semester and may be retained in the same grade.

What is the procedure that should be followed after an absence?

Students who have been absent must provide notice from the parent/guardian to the school explaining the reason for the absence within three (3) school days after their return from the absence. Parent/Guardian explanations should include the following information:

- 1. The first and last name of the student.
- 2. The date(s) the student was absent.
- 3. The reason the student was physically or mentally unable to attend, how the absence was related to the student's disability, or the nature of the emergency.

The principal/designee will determine whether the absence is classified as excused or unexcused. Students or parents/quardians are allowed three school days after the return from a student's absence to request homework. Schools must provide at least three school days for the assignment to be completed and submitted. Failure of the student to make up missed work from an excused absence will result in an unexcused absence counting toward the limitation of absences.

What happens if notification regarding the absence is not provided to the school within three (3) school days?

If an acceptable explanation of the absence is not provided within three school days, the absence is unexcused and, in accordance with NRS 392.130, is deemed truancy.

Prearranged Absences

Parents/Guardians must submit a written request to the school prior to the absence(s). The maximum number of arranged absences is ten (10) per school year. Forms to request an arranged absence are available in the Upper Office.

Closed Campus

Shadow Ridge High School operates under a closed campus policy. After arriving at school, students are not to leave school either during a class period, between class periods, or during lunch without a passport. Passports for appointments or other non-illness reasons may be obtained with parental permission in the attendance office. Students who need to go home during the school day due to illness must check out through the nurse's office. Violators will be considered truant. Once students enter the building, they may not be outside the building unless permission has been granted. This means that a student may not go to his/her vehicle at lunch unless permission has been given.

Yearbook News

Yearbooks are currently \$80 thru September 1, and can be purchased from the school bank or from jostens.com. A \$20 deposit can be made to the bank, holding the price. Yearbooks will increase to \$90 the month of September, \$100 from October 1-January 31, and then \$110 February - May.

FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA)

According to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), school records of students are confidential. FERPA allows school officials to provide what is called "directory information" without parental consent. However, public notice must be made before directory information may be made available. Parent notification is included in the Back to School Report and registration materials inform parents of the right to restrict the distribution of directory information. Directory information includes the student's name, address, grade level, date and place of birth, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height if a member of an athletic team, years of attendance, degrees and awards received, and schools attended. In addition, two federal laws require local educational agencies to provide military recruiters, upon request, with three directory information categories – names, addresses and telephone listings – unless disclosed without their prior written consent. Information other than directory information is not released without the written consent of the parent/guardian, eligible student or by court order.

Parents or guardians also have a right to review educational records kept by the district. To inspect these records, parents/ guardians should contact the principal to schedule a records review. In addition, parents may by written request, to the principal of the school, challenge the contents of student records that they believe are inaccurate. School Personnel are to respond to all request within a reasonable length of time not to exceed to (10) school days from the date of receipt of the request. A copy of school district Regulation 5125.1 pertaining to the education rights and privacy of parents and students is available upon request from the principal's office. The regulation can also be accessed through the Clark County School District website at www.ccsd.net.

Questions regarding educational records at the school should be directed to the principal in writing. Parents or eligible students have a right to file a complaint regarding the District's compliance with these requirements by contacting the Family Policy Compliance Office, U.S. Department of Education.
